Distinguished Teaching Chair	\$1,300,000	Provides most of a teacher's salary and gives special recognition for brilliant teaching. Recognizes the donor or someone of the donor's choosing, and helps alleviate financial pressure throughout the budget. A Distinguished Teaching Chair is the highest honor a faculty member can receive.
Faculty Sabbatical Program	\$1,200,000	Annually allows one Cate teacher to study and travel for the year, while the School also compensates a worthy replacement.
Teaching Chair	\$1,000,000	Annually yields \$45,000 toward the salary and benefits for one of Cate's distinguished teachers.
Professional Development Program	\$ 750,000	Provides \$30,000/yr that offers an average of \$1,200 each for fully half of Cate's faculty to participate in professional development classes, conferences, and workshops during every school year.
Faculty Recruitment Fund	\$ 500,000	Endows Cate's ability to find, interview, observe, and hire the best teachers available every year.

Professional Development Fund	\$ 300,000	Provides \$1,350/yr for ten teachers to engage in such professional development each school year.
Summer Sabbaticals	\$ 115,000	Grants \$5,000 each summer for a teacher to engage in professional development.
Faculty Salary Fund	\$ 100,000	Each named fund contributes \$4,000/yr to strengthen teacher compensation.
Faculty Laptop Fund	\$ 100,000	Supports ongoing availability and upgrades of laptops for teachers.

Students learn from and are enriched by those around them, whether they are teachers or schoolmates. Extraordinary schools bring extraordinary students to their classrooms and dormitories, to their stages and playing fields. Scholarships allow Cate to do that.

Cate Scholars Program	\$4,400,000	Provides full tuition for a Named Scholar in every Cate class, providing four students the opportunity to attend Cate annually.
Scholar Support Program	\$2,500,000	Awards partial tuition for a Named Scholar in every Cate class annually.
Full Scholarship	\$1,100,000	Gives full tuition for a Named Scholar throughout his or her Cate career. Begins anew every four years. This will fully fund 25 or more students—twice the size of the original School—in Cate's next 100 years.
Median Scholarship	\$ 800,000	Provides the median financial aid award to one student.
Partial	\$ 400,000	Provides a partial award to a student.
	\$ 250,000	Provides financial assistance to a middle income family.
Tuition Assistance Endowment	\$ 100,000	Supports Cate's ability to accept the best applicants regardless of their families' ability to pay full tuition.

Intellectual stimulation at Cate takes place inside and outside the classroom. Endowing curricular or co-curricular programs ensures that the School continues to provide a range of dynamic opportunities for student growth.

Academic Program	\$250,000	Endows any program's annual co-curricular activities, including field trips, films, guest speakers, and curriculum development.
Athletic Program	\$250,000	Endows any team's annual budget.
Speaker Series	\$500,000	Provides \$20,000 to bring speakers of note to Cate each year.
Performance Series	\$500,000	Brings 2 noteworthy performing artists or troupes to Cate each year.
Public Service Program	\$500,000	Endows one of Cate's preeminent programs.
Outdoor Wilderness Program	\$100,000	Supports wilderness training and equipment that will encourage and enable more Cate students to go out into the surrounding wilderness on their free days.
Classroom Technology	\$200,000	Supports upgrades and innovations in one department's classroom technology.
Library Periodicals	\$75,000	Provides periodical subscriptions both hard copy and online.
Cate Website Fund	\$100,000	Supports website staff and materials.
Headmaster's Discretionary Fund	\$100,000	Creates a discretionary fund for Cate that enables further strategic thinking and places faith in the administration and Board of Trustees as they envision the School's future or respond to an immediate need of a teacher, a student, or a program.
